Rural Public Building Energy Efficiency Support



Background

The Idaho Office of Energy Resources (OER) is accepting applications from rural cities and counties that want to save energy in existing public buildings. Approved applicants will receive a building energy audit which will identify energy saving opportunities, and may qualify for some cost-share funding on energy efficient retrofits.



The University of Idaho Integrated Design Lab will assist the OER in identifying energy saving opportunities in approved city- and county-owned buildings. The Integrated Design Lab is dedicated to the development of high performance energy efficient buildings in the Intermountain West through research, education and outreach efforts.

Process
