2022 Idaho Energy Landscape

The Governor's Office of Energy and Mineral Resources (OEMR) presents the 2022 update to the annual Idaho Energy Landscape. The strength of Idaho's economy and quality of life for its citizens depend upon access to affordable and reliable energy resources. Idaho's resilient and diversified economy is fueled by energy-dependent sectors, including technology, manufacturing, agriculture, tourism, healthcare, and construction, all of which benefit from Idaho's low cost of energy.

The 2022 Idaho Energy Landscape provides an overview of Idaho's energy profile, including energy resources, infrastructure, and major stakeholders. Additionally, the report discusses energy efficiency and conservation efforts and provides an outlook of future planned development. This year the report adds a new section on minerals, which reviews Idaho's mineral uses and contribution to the state economy.

The report concludes with a brief overview of energy research and education entities in Idaho who work to solve energy challenges in the state and around the globe. The State applauds their contributions towards workforce development and energy innovation.
